- Johannesburg. Without fibulas since birth, both legs amputated below knee
- **2001:** Mother dies after allergic reaction to malaria treatment
- 2003: Keen sportsman at school, turns to sprinting after rugby injury
- 2004: Running on carbon fibre prosthetic "cheetah blades", becomes Paralympic gold medallist and 200m world record holder
- competing against able-bodied athletes for "unfair advantage" later overruled by Court of Arbitration for Sport

Jan 2008: Banned by IAAF from

- Aug 2008: Wins three golds at Beijing Paralympics2011: Helps South Africa to IAAF
- World Championships relay final

 2012: First double amputee to compete at Olympics. Wins two golds
 - and a silver at London Paralympics

 Feb 14, 2013: Accused of killing girlfriend Reeva Steenkamp
