

Afghan civilian deaths

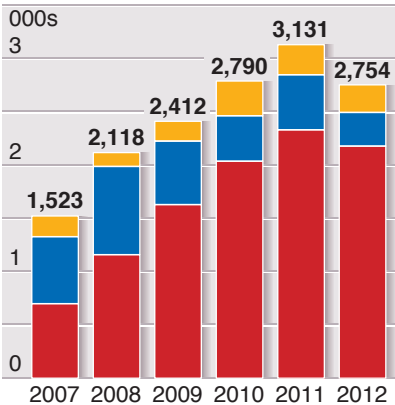
The number of civilian casualties in Afghanistan has fallen for the first time in six years, according to a UN report. The reduction was attributed to fewer suicide attacks and air strikes, and less fighting on the ground
