

Pistorius murder trial to be partially televised

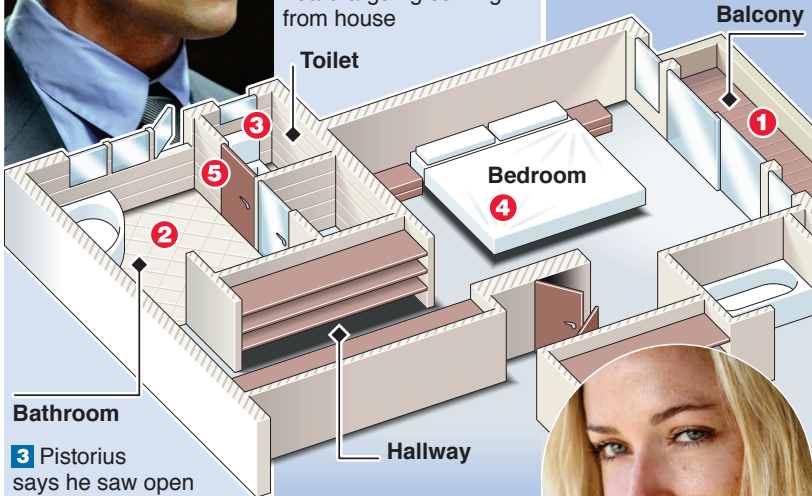
A South African judge has ruled that the entire audio of the trial of athlete Oscar Pistorius for the murder of his girlfriend Reeva Steenkamp can be broadcast live, with selected testimony also filmed and televised live

WHAT HAPPENED ON THE NIGHT OF THE SHOOTING



1 Pistorius says he woke in early hours and went to **balcony**, not wearing his prosthetic legs, to get fan. Before falling asleep he says he had been watching TV and Steenkamp had been doing yoga. Prosecutors say witness heard arguing coming from house

2 Pistorius says he heard noise in **bathroom** and thought it was intruder. He took 9mm pistol from under bed and shouted to Steenkamp to call police. He says room was pitch dark and he thought Steenkamp was in bed



3 Pistorius says he saw open window, thought intruder was in **toilet** and fired through door. Prosecutors say he knew that Steenkamp was in toilet. Four shots were fired, hitting Steenkamp three times. Prosecutors claim shots were fired downwards, suggesting Pistorius had his prosthetic legs on

4 Pistorius says he returned to **bedroom** and saw Steenkamp was not in bed. Prosecutors say pistol holster was found under left side of bed – where Steenkamp slept – implying it would have been impossible for Pistorius to get gun without realising she was not in bed

5 Pistorius says he put on his prosthetic legs, turned on light and broke down **toilet door** with cricket bat, before carrying Steenkamp downstairs to seek medical help
