Nicolas Maduro

Venezuela's vice president has assumed the presidency until new elections are held following the death of Hugo Chávez



- Born: Nov 23, 1962, Caracas
- 1970s and 80s: Begins political career as trade union activist while working as bus driver in Caracas
- 1994: Plays key role in securing release of Chávez from prison following 1992 failed coup attempt. Maduro's lawyer wife, *Cilia Flores*, leads Chávez's legal team
- 1998: Chávez wins presidential election. Maduro enters National
- Assembly, becomes Speaker in 2005

 2006: Appointed Foreign Minister.

 Promotes Chávez's left-wing agenda,
- Promotes Chávez's left-wing agenda, wins praise for easygoing style

 2011: Chávez diagnosed with cancer
- Oct 2012: Chávez wins third term.

 Maduro named Vice President
- Dec: Chávez's cancer recurs, he anoints Maduro as his successor
- Mar 5, 2013: Chávez dies Maduro to stand as government candidate in new presidential polls
