
## Armed Filipinos elusive after Malaysian raid

Malaysian security forces are battling a group of Filipino intruders in the rugged terrain of Borneo after they escaped a military assault with fighter jets and mortar fire on their hideout





- ▶ Members of Royal Sulu Army claim to be descendants of *Sultanate of Sulu* in southern Philippines, which ruled parts of northern Borneo for centuries
