▲ **A partial meltdown in one of two nuclear reactors at the Three Mile Island power plant in Pennsylvania caused the worst commercial nuclear accident in U.S. history**

1943: Sergei Rachmaninoff, composer and pianist, died Beverly Hills, California, U.S.

2003: At least 50 civilians were killed when a U.S. bomb missed its target and struck a Baghdad market

2009: A Chinese spying network was found to have infiltrated more than 1,000 computers in 103 countries

2011: Egypt's former President Hosni Mubarak and his family were placed under house arrest
