April 14, 1865

▲ **U.S. President Abraham Lincoln was assassinated at Ford's Theatre as part of a conspiracy to revive the Confederate cause in the American Civil War**

1927: Clarence Birdseye patented a method for quick freezing fish that preserved its texture

1993: In Moscow, 12 leaders of the 1991 coup against Mikhail Gorbachev went on trial for treason

1994: The government of Greece voted to strip former King Constantine and his family of their Greek citizenship

2008: Passenger train services between Calcutta in India and Dhaka in Bangladesh resumed after 43 years
