▲ **Paleontologists in Utah reported the discovery of a new species of birdlike, feathered dinosaur that lived around 126 million years ago**

**1493:** Pope Alexander VI, a Spaniard, decreed that all new lands discovered west of the Azores were Spanish

**1863:** The Maori uprising against the British began in New Zealand after 23 years of running conflict

**1998:** America's "Unabomber", who waged a 17-year campaign of bomb attacks, was given four life sentences

**1998:** The commander of the papal Swiss Guard was shot dead at the Vatican by another guardsman
