*April 28, 1770*

▲ **Captain James Cook's ship Endeavour reached the east coast of Australia, dropping anchor at Botany Bay, so called because of the unique specimens collected**

**1963:** Divers off West Australia found the wreck of the Dutch ship Vergulde Draeck, which sank in 1656

**1967:** Muhammad Ali was stripped of his world heavyweight boxing crown for refusing to join the U.S. Army

**1989:** Argentina, hit by hyper-inflation, ran out of money leaving thousands stranded without cash

**2005:** A sighting of the ivory-billed woodpecker, thought extinct since 1944, was confirmed in the U.S.
