

# Estimated ranges of North Korea's missiles

North Korea is believed to have more than 1,000 short to medium-range missiles which could strike South Korea and Japan, but its long-range rockets have a particularly bad track record – of seven launches since 1998, six ended in failure

**Unha:** Satellite launch version of Taepodong-2.  
Flight tests in 2009, April 2012 failed.  
Unha-3 launched successfully in December 2012

Estimated range: 6,000km.  
Test flights in 2006, 2009 and 2012 failed

**Taepodong-1**  
2,900km.  
Single test flight in 1998 failed

**KN-08**  
New missile shown at military parade in 2012.

2,500-3,200km.  
Has never flown

1,300km.  
200-450 missiles

700-800km.  
350 missiles
