## **Nicolas** Maduro Labour union

leader, chosen by late Venezuelan President Hugo Chávez as his preferred successor



- Born: Nov 23, 1962, Caracas
- 1970s-80s: Begins political career as trade union activist
- 1994: Plays key role in securing release of Chávez from prison following 1992 failed coup attempt
- 2000: Flected to National Assembly. Wins plaudits for his

combative defence of Chávez's left-wing Bolívar policies 2005: Elected President of

National Assembly 2006: Appointed foreign minister. Builds strong ties with Chávez's allies

- Russia, China, Iran and Libya 2012: Chávez names Maduro as

vice president and his successor Apr 2013: Following death of Hugo Chávez, Maduro stands as governing PSUV (United Socialist Party of Venezuela) candidate in presidential election, pledging to continue "21st century socialism"
