▲ **Jomo Kenyatta was elected first prime minister of a self-governing Kenya, becoming state president on independence from Britain the following year**

1937: The Golden Gate suspension bridge was opened in San Francisco, California

1967: Australia voted to allow Aborigines the same rights as other Australian citizens

1993: A suspected Mafia car bomb killed five people and badly damaged the Uffizi Gallery in Florence, Italy

2010: Spain's parliament approved by one vote a €15 billion austerity package to rein in the budget deficit
