*May 31, 2003*

▲ The last Air France Concorde touched down in Paris after its final flight from New York. It was retired after 27 years as it was no longer commercially viable

**1891:** Construction of the 9,288km Trans-Siberian Railway began with a ground-laying ceremony in Vladivostok

**1927:** The last Model T Ford, number 15,007,003, rolled off the production line

**1994:** The death toll in the Rwandan genocide was estimated to have reached 500,000

**2008:** Jamaican sprinter Usain Bolt broke the 100m world record for the first time, running 9.72s in New York
