June 25, 1876

▲ **Sioux chiefs Crazy Horse and Sitting Bull defeated General Custer and the U.S. 7th Cavalry at the Battle of Little Big Horn, known as “Custer’s Last Stand”**

1925: The first car telephone was exhibited in Germany

1950: North Korea invaded South Korea, crossing the 38th parallel and precipitating the Korean War

2006: The world’s two largest steel companies, Arcelor of France and India’s Mittal Steel, agreed a merger

2009: Pop superstar Michael Jackson died from cardiac arrest in Los Angeles, having ingested a powerful cocktail of sleeping drugs
