Israel to build military mega-bases in Negev

Israel is planning to construct four vast military bases in its southern Negev region by 2020, as part of a plan to free up more land for housing in Tel Aviv and central Israel

Tel Aviv: Israel Defence
Forces (IDF) will vacate land
worth \$14 billion, including its
headquarters compound –
known as *Kirya* – making
room for thousands of new
housing units. *Sde Dov* airport
will also be removed to free up
more land along coast

Beersheva: Three bases to be located in and around city – IDF technology campus, intelligence complex and teleprocessing division

Nevatim: Israel's largest air force base, already relocated from Tel Aviv in 2008
