A survey in 39 countries finds acceptance of homosexuality is particularly widespread in countries where religion is less central in people's lives.

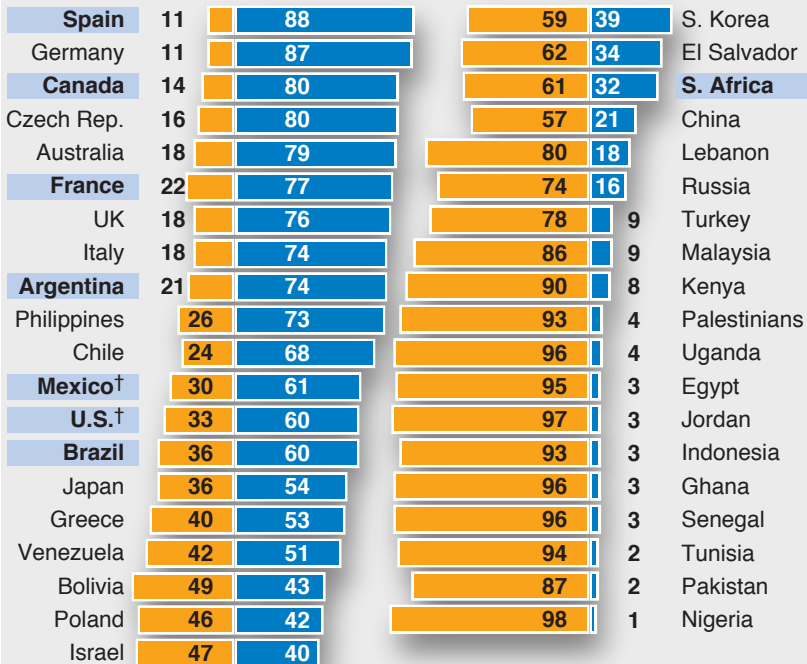
