

Wimbledon's future vision

The All England Club is embarking on a major new phase of redevelopment set to transform the tennis venue by 2020, with plans including a new roof on No. 1 Court, enhanced spectator access and an indoor tennis centre

Northern end: Three match courts repositioned, with new facilities for competitors underneath
