▲ **South Korean scientists presented the world's first cloned puppy, an Afghan hound named Snuppy, grown from a single cell from a three-year-old male dog**

1936: Jesse Owens won the first of his four gold medals at the Berlin Olympics

1963: The Beatles played at the Cavern Club for the last time

1998: Talks broke down between Iraq and UN weapons inspectors overseeing the destruction of Iraq's chemical and biological weapons

2010: In a deal with the UN, Ecuador agreed not to drill for oil in the Yasuni National Park for at least a decade in return for \$3.6 billion
