August 15, 1843

▲ The Tivoli Gardens, the world's second oldest amusement park, opened in Copenhagen, Denmark. The park inspired Walt Disney to create Disneyland

1918: The United States severed diplomatic relations with Russia in the wake of the Bolshevik takeover

1948: South Korea gained independence and was formally proclaimed the Republic of Korea

1990: Mikhail Gorbachev restored Soviet citizenship to author Alexander Solzhenitsyn

2003: Libya formally accepted responsibility for the 1988 plane bombing over Lockerbie, Scotland
