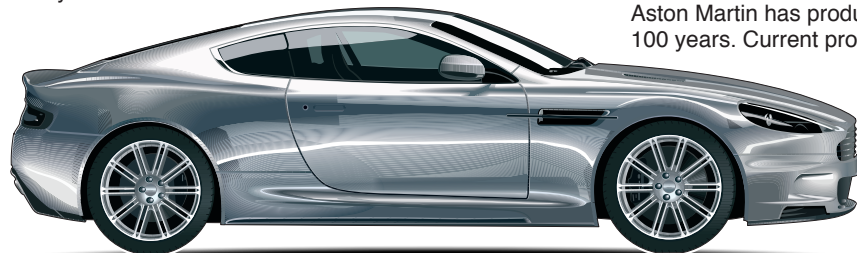

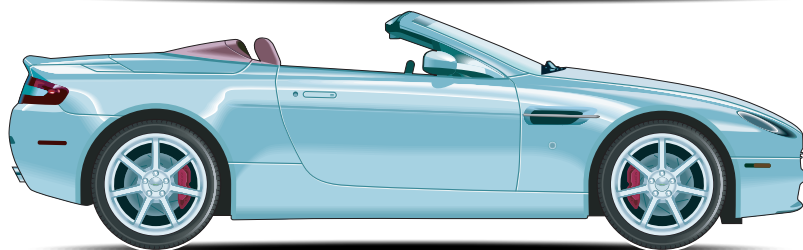


Aston Martin has produced 45,000 cars in the past 100 years. Current production is limited to five models*

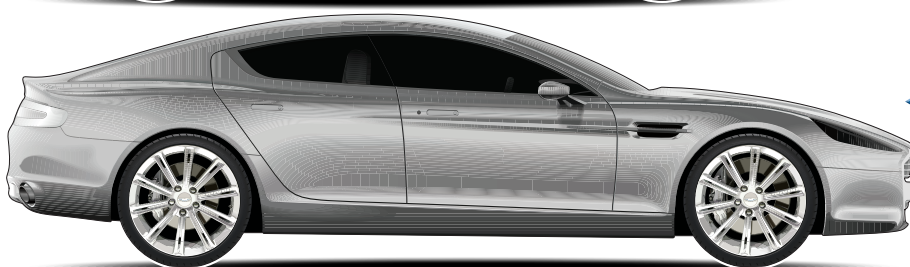
