
Syria crisis "worst since Rwanda genocide"

The UN says the number of people fleeing the conflict in Syria has escalated to an average of 6,000 a day during 2013 - a rate not seen since the genocide in Rwanda nearly two decades ago. An estimated 5,000 people are being killed each month
