

Mick Jagger's distinctive voice and performance, along with Keith Richards's guitar style, have been the trademark of the Rolling Stones throughout the band's career

- 1943: *Mick Jagger* born July 26, *Keith Richards* born Dec 18, in Dartford, Kent, England
- 1950: Boys meet as school classmates at age seven
- 1961: Jagger and Richards share flat in London with new friend, guitarist *Brian Jones*
- 1962: Rolling Stones make first appearance at London's Marquee Club
- 1963: Richards and Jagger begin songwriting partnership

- 1965: The Last Time is first UK No.1 featuring Jagger/Richards original composition. (I Can't Get No) Satisfaction is first international hit
- 1971: Hot Licks logo first used on Sticky Fingers album
- 2006: Richards undergoes cranial surgery after falling out of a tree in Fiji
- **2010:** Richards apologises after upsetting Jagger with unflattering revelations in bestselling memoir
- 2012: Stones mark 50th anniversary with reunion tour and new greatest hits compilation
- 2013: Stones appear as headline act at *Glastonbury Festival*
