- 1998: Graduates in law at Peoples' Friendship University, Moscow
- **2008:** Anti-corruption blog attracts wide following and propels him into becoming key opposition figure
- Feb 2011: Famously dubs Vladimir Putin's United Russia "the party of crooks and thieves"
- Dec: Inspires major street protests in Moscow following parliamentary election tarnished by allegations of widespread fraud. Jailed for 15 days
- Jul 10, 2013: Declares candidacy for Moscow's mayoral election
- Jul 18: Convicted of embezzling \$500,000 worth of timber from stateowned firm, Kirovles, in 2009.
