

Apple unveils new iPhone 5S and 5C

Apple has revamped the iPhone by launching two new handsets, including the first 64-bit processor to appear in a smartphone

▼ **IPHONE 5S** (*S* for speed/security)

▼ **IPHONE 5C** (*C* for colour)

Identical appearance to current iPhone 5, but its **A7 chip** is twice as fast

Slightly chunkier design

Both phones run new **iOS7** operating system

Scanning fingerprint

Recognition is **68% complete**

iPhone 5C case made from moulded **polycarbonate plastic** – cheaper than 5S's milled anodized aluminium design

Available in red, yellow, white, green, and blue, with existing iPhone 5's **A6 chip**. Two versions available with **16Gb** and **32Gb** storage

Brighter screen

Fingerprint scanner: Built into "Home" button. Allows users to unlock phone and replaces password when making mobile payments to **iTunes** store

Improved camera: Sensor is 15% larger, f/2.2 aperture lens captures more light for brighter results. Three storage options – **16Gb**, **32Gb** and **64Gb**

16Gb 5C two-year contract: **\$99**
