Today in History

September 7, 1978

▲ **Keith Moon, drummer with British rock group The Who and famed for his eccentric and often self-destructive behaviour, died from a drugs overdose at age 32**

1986: Desmond Tutu became the first black head of South Africa's Anglicans

1993: Six former Soviet republics agreed to keep the Russian rouble

2006: Ukrainian archaeologists claimed they had found underground pyramids that predated the pyramids at Giza

2008: Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac, the companies behind half of the \$12tn U.S. mortgage market, were placed under government control as the subprime crisis deepened
