September 9, 1513

▲ English forces repelled an invasion by Scottish troops at the Battle of Flodden. The Scottish king, James IV, was killed in the fighting

1948: The Democratic People's Republic of Korea was proclaimed

1968: Tennis star Arthur Ashe became the first African-American to win a Grand Slam, at the U.S. Open

1991: An Israeli teenager showed detectives how he hacked into U.S. Pentagon computers to find out how top-secret Patriot anti-missiles worked

2003: Argentina defaulted on a \$2.9 billion loan, the biggest default ever suffered by the IMF
