▲ American automobile pioneer Henry Ford introduced a moving assembly line into his plants to speed up mass production of the popular Model T car

1908: Crete rebelled against Turkish domination and united with Greece

1959: The Soviet Lunik III spacecraft relayed the first pictures of the far side of the moon

1988: A full-scale international rescue began when an Alaskan hunter spotted grey whales trapped under the ice

2012: Venezuelan President Hugo Chavez won a fourth term in office after defeating opposition leader Henrique Capriles
