October 21, 1901

▲ The Eastman Kodak Company of New Jersey was formed to market the hugely successful Brownie camera that brought photography to the masses

1923: The world's first planetarium was opened in Munich, Germany

1952: Jomo Kenyatta was arrested on charges of directing the Mau Mau movement in Kenya

1966: A slag heap slid and engulfed a school in Aberfan, Wales, killing 144 people, 116 of whom were children

1998: New Italian prime minister Massimo d'Alema became the first former Communist to head a major western European government
