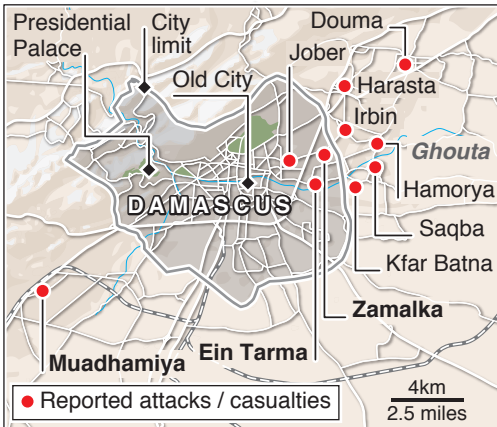


UN confirms sarin gas used in Syria attack

UN weapons inspectors have confirmed the use of sarin gas in an August 21 chemical attack in the rebel-held Damascus suburb of Ghouta

UN report identifies use of modified Iranian-designed **Falaq-2** artillery rockets and former Soviet **M-14** rockets at **Zamalka**, **Ein Tarma**, and **Muadhmiya**

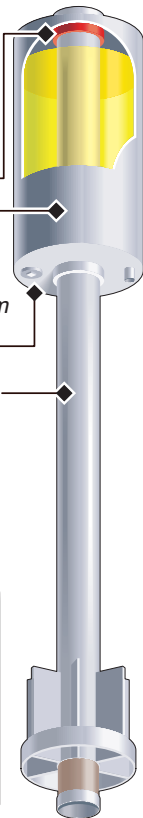
