

Hurricane Manuel to hit storm-battered Mexico

Tropical Storm Manuel has surged to hurricane strength off the Pacific coast, threatening Mexico with more destruction. Flooding rains starting last week from Manuel and Hurricane Ingrid have killed at least 80 people, driven 40,000 from their homes and stranded 40,000 more in Acapulco
