  Council of Economic Advisers
  under President Bill Clinton
- 2004-10: President of San
- Francisco Federal Reserve Bank
- 2010: Appointed Fed Vice Chair
- Feb 1, 2014: Succeeds outgoing Chairman *Ben Bernanke* as head of U.S. Federal Reserve
