November 21, 1783

▲ **Two Frenchmen made the first successful flight in a hot air balloon, travelling above Paris for 25 minutes. It was the first ever untethered manned flight**

1620: The Pilgrim Fathers aboard the Mayflower off Cape Cod signed a plan for governing the new American colony

1913: Tokugawa Keiki, the last of the Japanese shoguns, hereditary military commanders, died

1980: Nearly 80 percent of U.S. TV viewers tuned in to the popular soap Dallas to find out who shot J.R. Ewing

1995: Parties at the Bosnia peace talks in Dayton, Ohio, agreed a deal to end the bloody Balkan conflict
