November 25, 1973

▲ Greek dictator Colonel George Papadopoulos was overthrown by rival officers in a bloodless coup. He had ousted the government and King Constantine II in 1967

1884: A patent was issued for evaporated milk, an unsweetened milk with up to 75% of the water removed

1963: The state funeral of assassinated U.S. President John F. Kennedy took place in Washington

1969: Beatle John Lennon returned his MBE to protest at Britain's support for the U.S. in the Vietnam War

1970: Writer Yukio Mishima committed ritual suicide in protest against the westernisation of Japan
