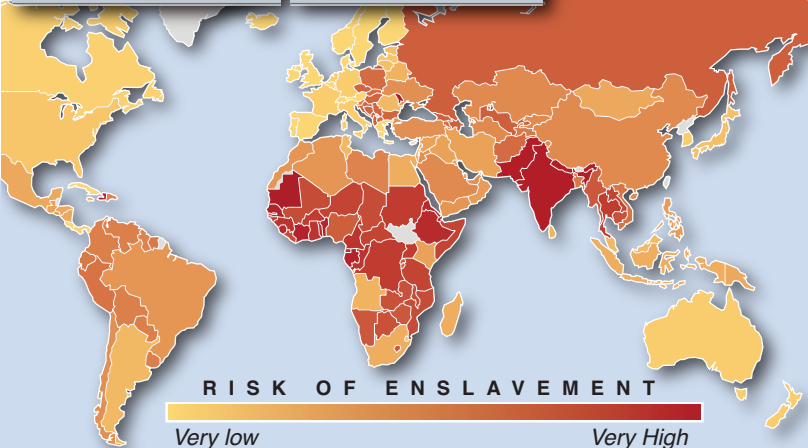


Modern slavery exposed

Nearly 30 million people worldwide are victims of sex trafficking, debt bondage, forced labour and other forms of modern slavery, according to the Global Slavery Index 2013
