
## Syrian army adopts "cleansing" tactics

Syrian forces have embarked on a strategy of "cleansing" towns and villages by bombarding them with their heaviest weapons in a bid to control a strategic government supply route



- 1 Jun-Jul: Cleansing begins when government troops occupy Basnqoul, Kafr Shalaya, and Urum al Joz.
  Reports of massacres of residents –
- 2 Jul 17, Ariha: Main market comes under mortar bombardment. Market is crowded at end of daylong fast during Ramadan

more than 15,000 people displaced

- 3 Aug 1-3, Kafr Najd: Troops execute civilians in door-to-door raids
- 4 Aug 2-3, Ariha: Troops enter town, killing civilians. Aug 19: Rebels retake town and close supply route
- 5 Aug 21-Sep 2: Two-week Battle of Ariha involves 600 rebels facing 1,000 government troops. 70,000 inhabitants displaced
