



## Today in History

*January 7, 1610*

▲ **Italian astronomer Galileo Galilei first sighted Jupiter's four largest satellite moons, using the telescope he had developed the previous year**

**1830:** Mount Clare railway station, which claims to be the world's oldest, opened in the U.S. city of Baltimore

**1844: Bernadette Soubirous, who claimed to have seen visions of the Virgin Mary at Lourdes, was born**

**1904:** The shipping distress call CQD (seek you, danger) was introduced. It was replaced two years later by SOS

**1979: Vietnamese forces and Cambodian rebels captured Phnom Penh and ousted the Khmer Rouge**
