▲ **South Korea confirmed that over \$1 billion worth of livestock, including 12 percent of all pigs, had been lost due to an outbreak of foot and mouth disease**

**1842:** A British force of 9,000 men was massacred in the Khyber Pass

**1964:** The Beatles' first release in the U.S., I Wanna Hold Your Hand, sold one million copies in three weeks

**2004:** Italy's Constitutional Court overturned a law protecting senior government officials while in office

**2012:** The Costa Concordia cruise ship, with 4,252 people on board, partially sank off the coast of Tuscany, with the loss of 32 lives
