▲ The world's first nuclear-powered submarine, USS Nautilus, was launched. Her many records included the first submerged transit of the North Pole in 1958

**1996:** British fashion designer John Galliano presented his first haute couture collection for Givenchy in Paris

**2000:** President Witt of Ecuador was ousted following mass protests at his plans to reduce inflation by replacing the national currency

**2008:** The last native speaker of the Eyak language in Alaska died, rendering the language extinct

**2011:** South Korean forces freed a hijacked freighter from Somali pirates
