January 24, 1960

▲ A major insurrection began in Algiers in protest against French President Charles de Gaulle's policy of self-determination for Algeria

41AD: The Roman emperor Caligula, known for his depravity and cruelty, was assassinated by his own guards

1969: General Franco declared martial law in Spain

1999: The International Olympic Committee expelled six members who had accepted payments or gifts from would-be host cities
