

Timeline of Ukraine political conflict



■ **Nov 21, 2013:** President **Viktor Yanukovich** decides to back out of trade deal with European Union in favour of closer ties with Moscow

■ **Nov 30:** Police launch violent crackdown in Kiev, detaining dozens of anti-government protesters

■ **Dec 17:** Russia agrees to buy \$15 billion of Ukrainian bonds and cut price of natural gas to Ukraine

■ **Jan 22, 2014:** Two protesters die from gunshot wounds during clashes with police in Kiev. Protests spread to cities across Ukraine

■ **Jan 28:** Parliament scraps anti-protest law. Yanukovich accepts resignation of PM and cabinet

■ **Jan 29:** Parliament passes amnesty law for detained protesters, on condition that occupied buildings are vacated. Protesters reject move

■ **Jan 30:** President **Vladimir Putin** says Russia will wait until Ukraine forms new government before fully implementing \$15bn bailout deal
