▲ A court in Memphis, Tennessee, convicted James Earl Ray of the assassination of Martin Luther King in April 1968 and sentenced him to 99 years in jail

1876: Alexander Graham Bell made the world's first telephone call

1994: Thousands of students in France demonstrated against a law allowing employers to pay young people less than the minimum wage

1995: Spain sent a gunboat to protect its trawlers fishing in international waters off Canada

2006: NASA's Mars Reconnaissance Orbiter entered orbit around the red planet after a seven-month journey
