Arena Amazonia

Manaus: Three workers killed in separate accidents during construction. Stadium several months behind schedule

Arena Fonte Nova

Salvador: Roof section partially collapsed in May 2013 following heavy rain, requiring major repairs

Arena Pantanal

Cuiaba: To be inspected for possible structural damage caused by October 2013 fire

Estadio Nacional, Brasilia

Plagued by various delays and strikes. Project cost almost double its original budget. Worker died after fall from roof in June 2012

Arena da Baixada, Curitiba

In danger of being scrapped due to construction delays
