March 19, 1932

▲ **Australia's iconic Sydney Harbour Bridge officially opened. It is the world's tallest steel arch bridge, measuring 134m (440ft) from top to water level**

1964: The Great St Bernard Tunnel between Switzerland and Italy opened

1997: The World Health Organisation announced that a new treatment for tuberculosis could save millions of lives over the next 10 years

2002: Zimbabwe was suspended from the Commonwealth after Robert Mugabe's dubious election victory

2009: Austrian Josef Fritzl was jailed for life for the 24-year imprisonment and rape of his daughter
