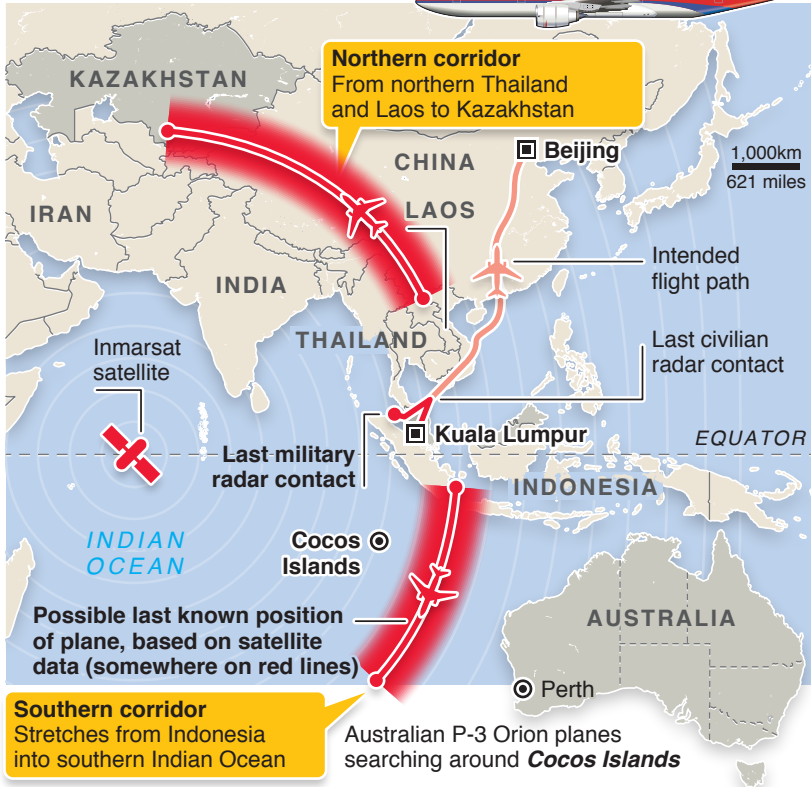
Twenty-six countries looking for plane, with Australia leading southern search
