
What we know about Flight MH370

- 1 00:41, Mar 8: Malaysia Airlines Flight MH370 carrying 239 people departs Kuala Lumpur International Airport bound for Beijing
- 2 01:21: Plane's transponder which identifies aircraft, location and altitude disabled
- 3 01:30-02:15: Malaysian and Thai military radars show aircraft turning sharply to west and then north
- 4 08:11: Inmarsat satellite picks up automatic "handshake" data between aircraft and ground station indicating plane was still flying seven hours after losing contact with air traffic control
- 08:19: Evidence of further "partial handshake" at this time still being analysed by experts
- 09:15: Next scheduled contact no response from aircraft
