▲ **An eight-story garment factory collapsed in Dhaka, Bangladesh, killing over 1,100 people in the deadliest ever accident in the history of the clothing industry**

1923: Sigmund Freud published his paper *Das Ich und das Es* (the Ego and the Id), fundamentally important in the development of psychoanalysis

1975: Three people died when Baader-Meinhof extremists attacked the German embassy in Sweden

1989: Australian researchers claimed that crocodiles suffered from stress
