▲ **George Washington was inaugurated as the first President of the United States, taking the oath of office on the balcony of Federal Hall in New York City**

1975: Saigon fell to communist North Vietnamese forces, ending the longest conflict of the 20th century

1993: Tennis star Monica Seles was stabbed on court during a match in Hamburg, Germany

2004: Pictures of Iraqi prisoners being tortured and sexually humiliated by U.S. soldiers caused worldwide outrage

2009: Chrysler became the first major U.S. automaker to file for bankruptcy, a shock to the industry
