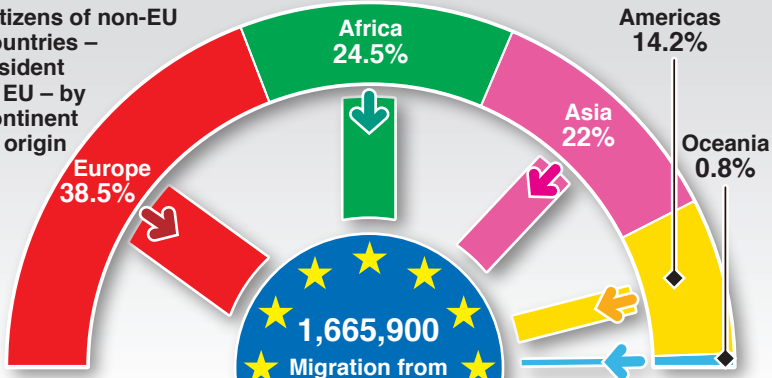


Ins and outs of EU migration

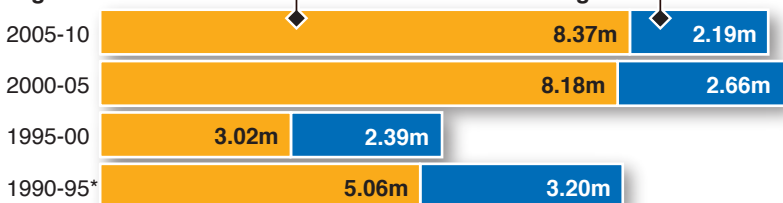
