May 26, 1659

▲ **Aurangzeb, sixth and last of the great Mughal emperors, formally ascended the throne. The Mughal Empire reached its greatest extent during his 49-year reign**

1834: The Portuguese Civil War ended with the capitulation of the pretender, Dom Miguel

1969: John Lennon and Yoko Ono began their “Bed-In” for world peace

1972: Australia’s Willandra National Park, inhabited by Aborigines for 15,000 years and home to numerous native species, was established

2006: Europe’s largest two-level train station, Berlin Hauptbahnhof, was opened in Germany
