## Court ousts Thai leader

Thailand's Prime Minister Yingluck Shinawatra has been ordered to step down after the Constitutional Court found her guilty of abuse of power



## Sep 2006: Prime Minister *Thaksin*

- Shinawatra ousted in military coup
- Dec 2007: Pro-Thaksin *People*Power Party wins election
- Aug 2008: Thaksin flees Thailand
- Dec: Mass anti-Thaksin protests paralyse Bangkok. Constitutional Court bans People Power Party. Abhisit Vejjajiva becomes premier
- Mar-May 2010: Pro-Thaksin
- supporters stage mass rallies.
  Protests end in army crackdown
   more than 90 people killed
- Jul 2011: Yingluck Shinawatra, Thaksin's sister, leads Pheu Thai Party to general election victory
- Nov 2013: Anti-government protests begin in Bangkok
- Feb 2014: Snap election disrupted by protesters polls later annulled
- May 2014: Yingluck ordered to step down
